# 3. Make a new design

- **Affinity** was recently bought out by Canva, made **free**
  - “Adobe competitor”
- **Vector** graphics
  - No pixels, **shapes**
  - scales **infinitely**
- fonts = shapes

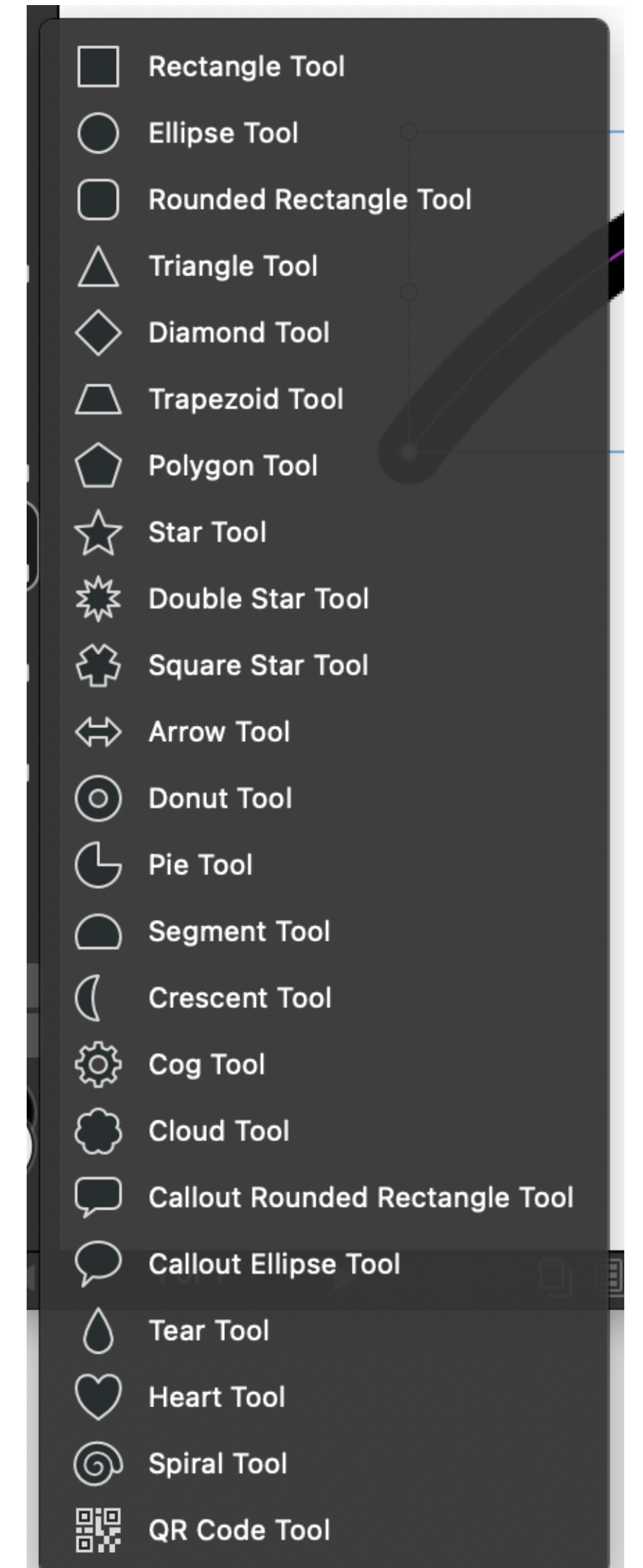
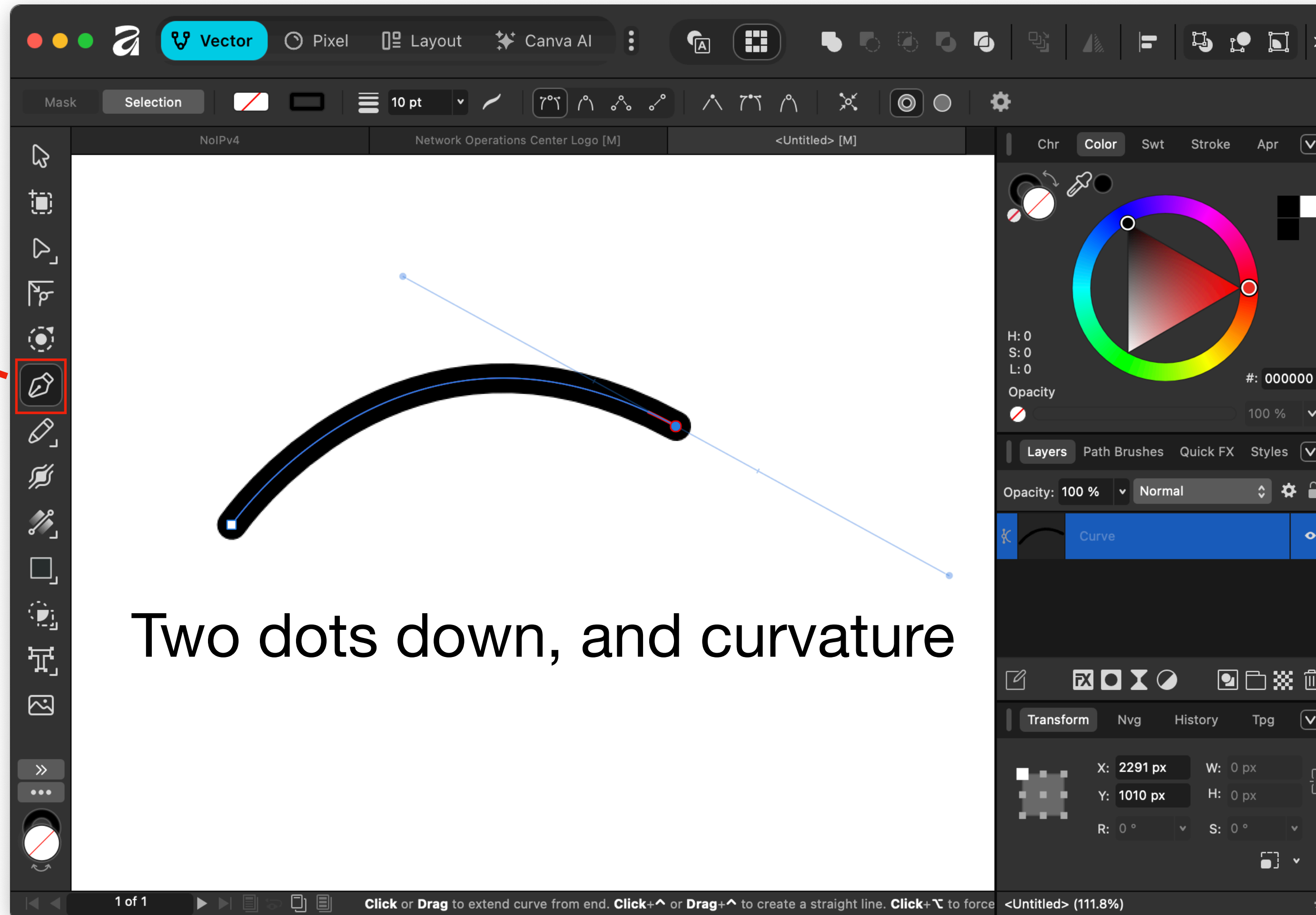




# 3. Make a new design

# 4. Print it

- **Various printing companies** (secret trick: get the outdoor/PP/vinyl ones)
  - OnlinePrinters (cheap, high quantity, do get “data check”)
  - WirMachenDruck (recommended a lot by German hackers)
  - Stickermule (only if using \$1 for 10 stickers discount)
- Printing it yourself
  - lower quality unless you know what you’re doing (I don’t)
  - better for test prints (low quantity)
